### **Getting Hyperion WRP to 100% Water Recycling**

Huub Cox, Nasir Emami, and Christina Jones welcomed the LABS members at the Hyperion WRF to see the latest updates on the water recycling program. Huub Cox is the program manager of the Hyperion 2035 Program, Nasir Emami is project manager of the Hyperion Membrane Bioreactor Pilot Facility, and Christina Jones is project manager of the Hyperion Advanced Water Purification Facility. The team provided a short overview of the Hyperion 2035 program goals, the current status of program development, the advanced water purification processes that are being considered, and some of the technical challenges each project is encountering.

The tour highlighted the Hyperion Membrane Bioreactor Pilot Facility and Hyperion Advanced Water Purification Facility projects that are 90% complete. The LABS members were impressed with the construction progress and seeing the steps the City are taking to make 100% water recycling a reality. We are looking forward to



### **Relativity Space**

On Thursday, October 20th about 25 CWEA LABS members gathered in the late afternoon in front of the lobby of Relativity Space in Long Beach. Relativity is a new company formed in 2015 with the ambitious goal of manufacturing rockets using "additive manufacturing" technologies, i.e., 3D printing of metal components, to quickly, cheaply, and efficiently manufacture large rockets capable of delivering payloads, and eventually astronauts, into space. The company is currently on the cusp of their first launch, a 110' tall "Terran 1" rocket made at the Long Beach facility.

After checking in, the LABS members were split into 3 groups to tour the facility. The tour then proceeded to the Aeon rocket engine assembly area, before moving on to the signature large 3D "print cells" where everything from rocket engines and nozzles to the huge 8' diameter fuel and oxidizer tanks are made. While one can't directly observe the components being additively manufactured due to dangers of exposure to the process, you can observe the manufacturing in progress through large flat screens monitors mounted just outside the curtained off cells.

The tour finished at the outdoor test stand area where finished tanks were hydrostatically leak tested prior to final stacking and assembly. The tour took about an hour and was followed by a group photo taken back in front of the lobby prior to all adjourning to dinner at the nearby El Torito restaurant. Dinner included an informa-

tive 30-minute PowerPoint presentation by Mr. Abille and insightful comments by LACSD Environmental Compliance Inspector Jason Finn who suggested the tour. Many thanks to Relativity's managers for their willingness to show us their operation and their patience with us asking our decidedly non-rocket scientist level questions.
