



From the North:

Pumps Ragging?

Problem Solved

Case Study: Half Moon Bay CA

Problem:

- Pumps clogging usually twice per week and took 1 hour to clean each pump.

SSS WDR Online Training

Summit Partners Webinar Available on SERP Requirements in Reissued SSS WDR

On March 22, the Clean Water Summit Partners hosted a free Zoom webinar focused on required updates to Spill Emergency Response Plans under the reissued Statewide Sanitary Sewer System Waste Discharge Requirements Order (SSS WDR), which was adopted by the SWRCB on December 6, 2022. The video recordings and presentation slide decks are accessible here. The webinar featured presentations on updates to enrollees' Spill Emergency Response Plans which are due by June 4, 2023. The presenters reviewed requirements in the reissued General Order driving changes to existing Response Plans, walked through the portions of the plan requiring changes to provide guidance on performing updates, and discussed putting these potential changes into practice by June 4, 2023. There were multiple in-depth Question-and-Answer sessions, and these resources are all available and archived online. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out to Jared Voskuhl during the interim, or, you may use the interactive FAQ document to which the State Water Resources Control Board's team is providing responses.
