# Transforming LA County's Food Waste into Renewable Energy

**Tom Fang**, **Winnie Shaw**, and **Johnmar Deguzman** shared with LABS members how the Sanitation Districts are transforming food waste into renewable energy for LA County and what this means for the future of our community. Winnie explained in depth the recent California Senate Bill 1383 regarding organic waste recycling during a virtual lunch presentation. Johnmar discussed how the Sanitation Districts has responded to the law through the agency's Food Waste Recycling Program by accepting organic waste, generating biogas through anaerobic co-digestion, and converting it into renewable natural gas as vehicle fuel. Afterwards, the team engaged in a Q&A session regarding the unforeseen consequences, enforcement of the SB, and where the program is next. Thanks for the interactive and educational presentation.



## **SOFI Stadium Treatment Plant Tour and Dinner**

Andrew Komor and Michelle Hoalton from PACE Advanced Water Engineering welcomed LABS members at SoFi Stadium to see the state-of-the-art, 5-acre, man-made lake that functions as a flood attenuation and stormwater treatment system as well as an irrigation storage reservoir fed by site runoff and recycled water. An advanced treatment system addresses the high ammonia levels in the recycled water and nutrients from the runoff and provides ongoing circulation and treatment to maintain pristine lake water quality. This is a first-of-its-kind system in California and challenged the boundaries of stormwater/ wastewater reuse by achieving a Regional Water Quality Control Board permit to discharge commingled

stormwater and recycled water. LABS members got an inside look at the Treatment Pump Station and strolled along the Stadium's Lake Park to look at the engineering features.

## Gain the recognition you deserve!

- **3.** Click APPLY.
- 4. Select the category

- 5. Complete the online application.
- **6.** Local Section winners announced in December and January and forwarded to the State for review.
- 7. State winners announced in March. Good luck!


